1. Aim

To set out explicitly the rights and obligations of both parties and the prohibitions applicable to both parties.

2. Service

2.1 The "service" herein referred to, is that party B, through www.feydj.com, provides ZABCS service to the website _____ indicated by party A.

2.2 ZABCS is operational on a 24 hours daily basis throughout the whole year, except during periods of maintenance on the part of party B.

3. Rights and obligations

3.1 Party B has the obligation to provide ZABCS services to party A.

3.2 It is prohibited for party A to run ZABCS in any illegal website or any websites which may commit crimes against the laws of the People's Republic of China. If this happens, party A incurs all responsibility.

4. Payment

4.1 Party A is willing to purchase ZABCS (VIP version / Luxury version / Standard version / Economy version) from Party B.

4.2 Party A will pay party B the "ZABCS service fee" of US\$ _____ per year for _____ year(s); maximum monitor numbers are _____.

4.3 Payment method.

4.4 If Party A does not pay the service fee within 3 days of signing this contract, party B will terminate the ZABCS service.

5. Confidentiality

5.1 Except as expressly set forth herein, the parties shall maintain in confidence the confidential Information of the other side. The parties shall not disclose such confidential Information to any third party without the prior written consent of the other side.

5.2 Both parties shall abide by the terms of confidentiality in this contract and accept

the obligation to maintain the confidentiality of information after the termination of the contract. This obligation shall end only upon the consent of the other party.

5.3 After the termination of the contract, each party will return all information related to the other party.

6. Duration

The duration of this contract is _____year(s). At its expiration, within 30 days, with the agreement of both parties, the contract can be extended after party A has paid a new service fee.

7. Other provisions

7.1 In the case of any dispute under this contract, both parties shall try to resolve the issue through negotiation. If negotiation fails, both parties agree to submit the matter to binding arbitration in the People's Court of Chaoyang District, Beijing.

7.2 If party B needs to shut down for a short while for maintenance or detection of interference by any third party, the term of the contract shall be extended for a period equivalent to that of the shutdown, but no other kinds of claim for damages can be made by party A.

7.3 If either of the contracting parties is prevented from executing the contract by events of Force Majeure such as war , serious flood , fire , typhoon or earthquake , or other events agreed upon between the two parties, the party being prevented from executing the contract shall notify the other party of the occurrence of the Force Majeure event within five days. Both parties shall then seek to settle the problem of further execution of the contract through friendly negotiations as soon as possible .

8. Other issues

8.1 The contract will be effective from the date on which it is signed by both sides.

8.2 The contract is in duplicate and each party shall hold one copy, each copy having equal force in law.

8.3 Any annex will form an integral part of this contract. The annex and this contract are of equal validity. The fax copy of this contract has equal force in law.
